#### BEFORE DEPARTURE

Proof of negative COVID-19 test results

Travelers who are not fully vaccinated arriving by air from selected countries must have a negative COVID-19 PCR test result. The test must be taken within 72 hours before departure.

Travelers may have a negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test result. The test must be taken within 24 hours before departure. Those without PCR test results may be fined \$200 CHF by the control authorities. Those with negative rapid antigen test results must take a PCR or antigen test on arrival in Switzerland.

## HEALTH REGULATIONS

Before visiting Switzerland you may need to get the following vaccinations or take the following precautions. It is best to seek medical advice as your individual health and your planned activities will be a factor. Seek advice 4-6 weeks before travel.

### Required Vaccinations

- There are no vaccinations required for entry to Switzerland.

### Routine and Recommended Vaccinations

- It is recommended that travellers are up to date on routine vaccinations including measles-mumps-rubella (MMR), diphtheria-pertussis-tetanus (DPT), varicella (chickenpox), polio, and yearly flu shots.
- As hepatitis A outbreaks occur throughout the world and sometimes in countries with a low risk for hepatitis A, travellers should consult with their doctor prior to travel to see if the hepatitis A vaccine is necessary.
- A hepatitis B vaccination is recommended for those who may have sexual contact with a new partner, who may get a tattoo or piercing, or have any medical procedures.
- A rabies vaccination is recommended for those planning an outdoor holiday, for wildlife professionals and researchers, or for those who may come into contact with bats.

## CUSTOMS

### IMPORT REGULATIONS

#### Free to Import

#### Tobacco (restricted to travellers 17 years and over)

One of the following:

- 250 cigarettes; or
- 250 grams other tobacco products.

#### Alcohol (restricted to travellers 17 years and over)

All of the following:

- 5 litres up to 18% alcohol volume; and
- 1 litre over 18% alcohol volume.

#### Food

All of the following:

- 1kg meat;
- 1kg butter and cream with a fat content of 15% or higher;
- and 5kg oils, fats, and margarine for human consumption.

### **Currency**

- There are no restrictions on the importation of liquid funds into Switzerland.
- Funds of CHF 10,000 or more will be subject to checks and entered into the Customs Administration. For further information, please visit the Federal Customs Administration [Cash, foreign currencies, securities](#).

### **Other goods**

- Personal effects such as clothing, sports gear, and personal electronic equipment. These goods must leave Switzerland when the traveller leaves.
- 30 days' worth of medicinal products for personal use only.
- Safe to handle fireworks up to 2.5kg.
- Vehicles for personal use may be imported without declaration by visitors.
- VAT will be levied on goods where the total value exceeds CHF 300. For further information, please visit the Federal Customs Administration [Value of goods exceeds CHF 300](#).

### **Prohibited**

#### **The following are goods which cannot be brought into the country.**

- Daggers and knives with one-handed opening systems (such as flick-knives).
- Weapons disguised as other objects.
- Electric-shock devices.
- Automatic and semiautomatic firearms.
- Beating weapons, throwing weapons and slings.
- Silencers and laser and night-vision devices.
- Fireworks not considered safe to handle, such as those that explode on the ground.
- Stolen cultural property.
- Pirated and counterfeited goods. For further information, please visit [Stop Piracy](#).
- Radar equipment.
- Products considered to be doping substances.
- Narcotics for unlawful use.
- Certain plants are prohibited. For further information, please visit Federal Customs Administration [Plants, cut flowers and protection of species \(CITES\)](#).
- Animal products from outside the EU are generally prohibited, with some exceptions. For further information, please visit Federal Customs Administration [Plants, cut flowers and protection of species \(CITES\)](#).
- Most animal and plant species protected by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) are prohibited from importation, with some exceptions which instead require permits. ### **Restricted**



**These goods are strictly regulated, and in most cases require a permit to be obtained prior to arrival.**

## HEALTH REGULATIONS

Before visiting Indonesia you may need to get the following vaccinations or take the following precautions. It is best to seek medical advice as your individual health and your planned activities will be a factor. Seek advice 4-6 weeks before travel.

### Required Vaccinations

- There is no risk of yellow fever in Indonesia. The government of Indonesia requires proof of yellow fever vaccination from travellers 9 months of age or older who are arriving from a country with risk of yellow fever. For further information on this recommendation, please visit the CDC [Yellow Fever Advice](#).

### Routine and Recommended Vaccinations

- It is recommended that travellers are up to date on routine vaccinations including measles-mumps-rubella (MMR), diphtheria-pertussis-tetanus (DPT), varicella (chickenpox), polio, and yearly flu

shots.

- A hepatitis A vaccination is recommended as travellers may contract hepatitis A through contaminated food or water in Indonesia, regardless of where they are eating or staying.
  - A hepatitis B vaccination is recommended for those who may have sexual contact with a new partner, who may get a tattoo or piercing, or have any medical procedures.
  - A typhoid vaccination is recommended for most travellers, especially those staying with friends or relatives, visiting smaller cities or rural areas, or for those that are adventurous eaters.
  - Travellers may need a Japanese Encephalitis vaccination depending on their travel plans, particularly if they will be in Indonesia longer than a month or plan to visit rural areas or spend significant time outdoors. Consultation with a doctor regarding this vaccination should be sought prior to travel. For further information on this recommendation, please visit the CDC [Japanese Encephalitis Advice](#).
  - A rabies vaccination is recommended for those planning an outdoor holiday, for wildlife professionals such as veterinarians and researchers, for those who are taking a long trip or moving to Indonesia, and children as they are more likely to receive animal bites

### IMPORT REGULATIONS

#### Free to Import

#### Tobacco

One of the following:

- 200 cigarettes;
- 25 cigars; or
- 100 grams of tobacco.

#### **Alcohol**

- 1 litre of alcohol.

#### **Currency**

- Funds of more than Rp100,000,000 or its foreign equivalent must be declared to the customs authorities.

#### **Other Goods**

- A reasonable quantity of perfume.
- Personal goods up to the value of US\$250 per individual or US\$1000 per family.

#### **Prohibited**

**The following are goods which cannot be brought into the country.**

- Narcotics and psychotropic drugs.
- Pornographic materials.
- Firearms and weapons.

#### **Restricted**

**These goods are strictly regulated, and in most cases require a permit to be obtained prior to arrival.**
